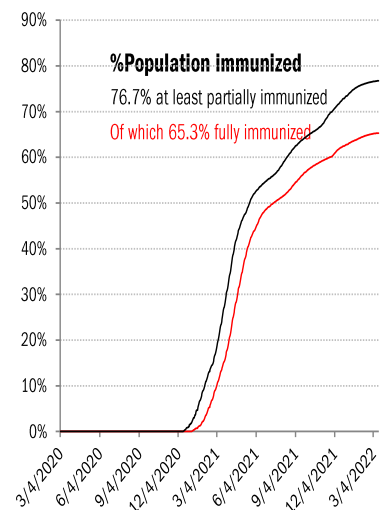
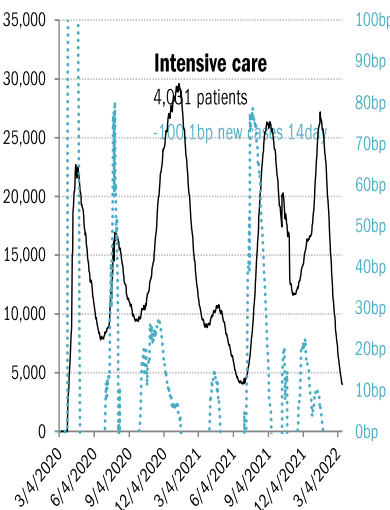
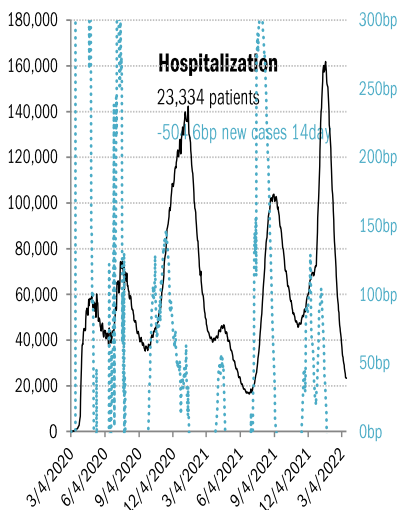
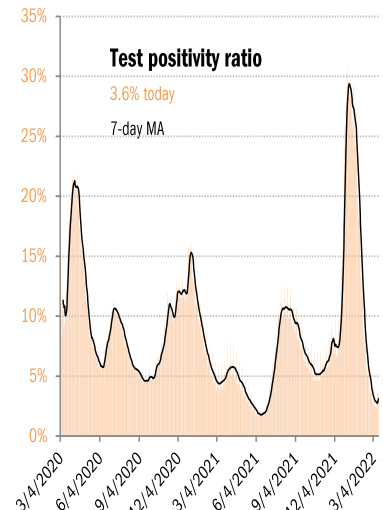
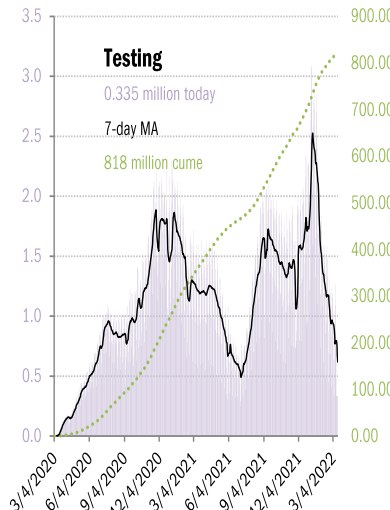
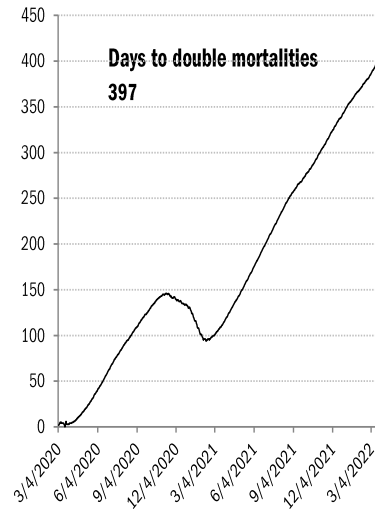
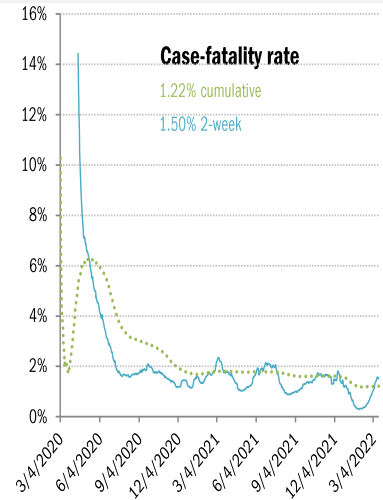
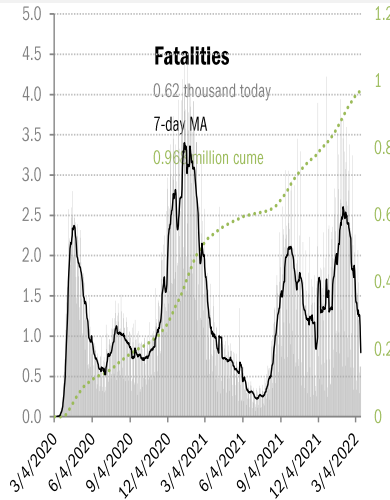
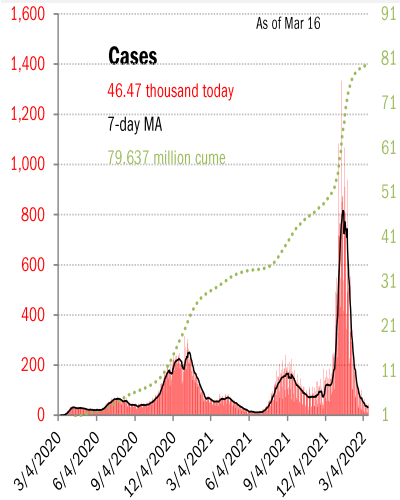
## The demographics of US vaccination

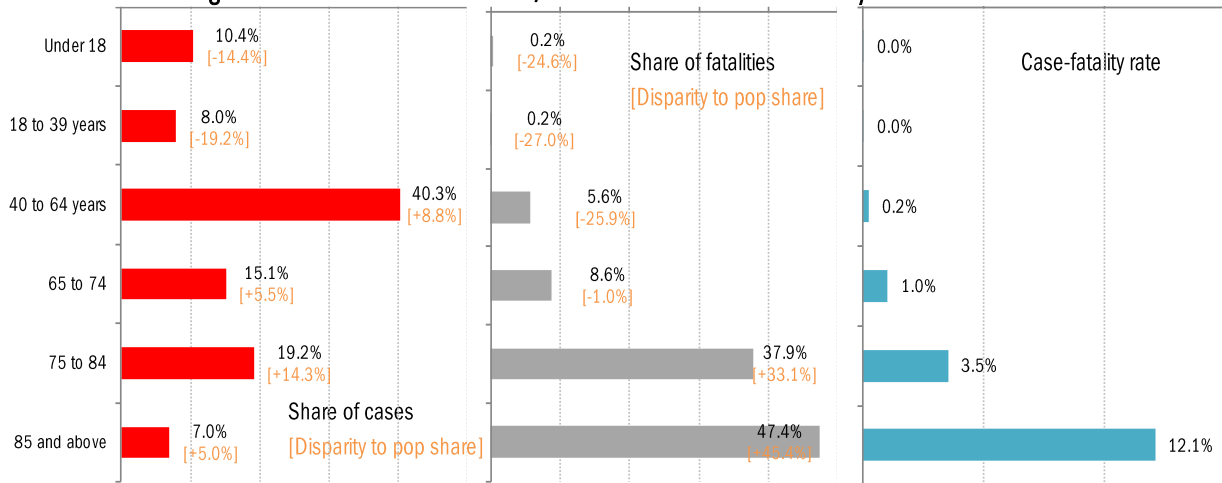

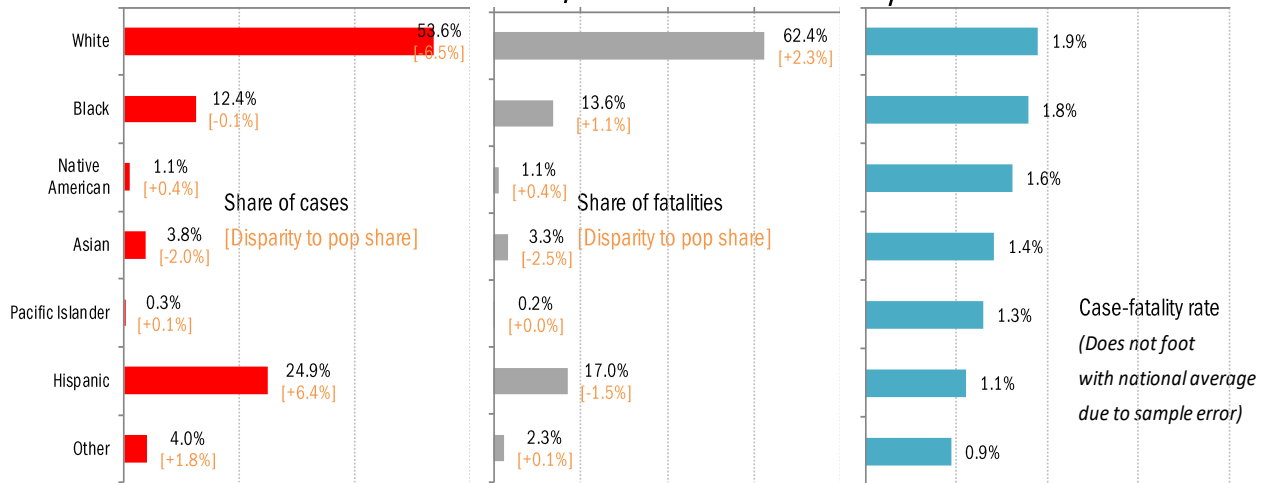

Age distribution of US cases, fatalities and case-fatality rates

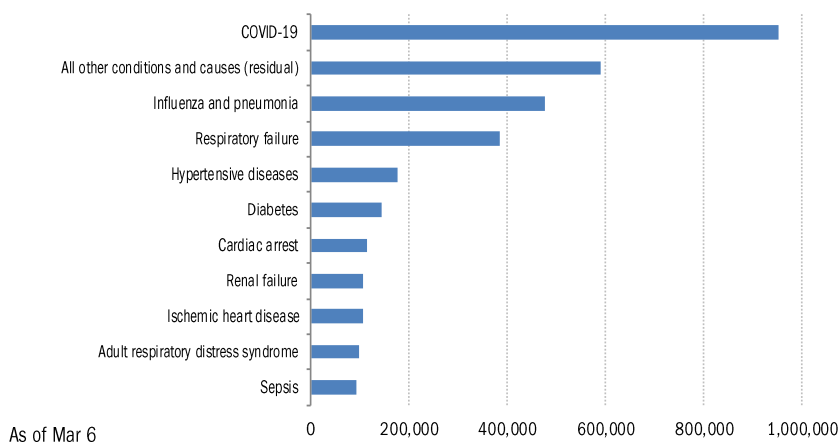


Racial distribution of US cases, fatalities and case-fatality rates

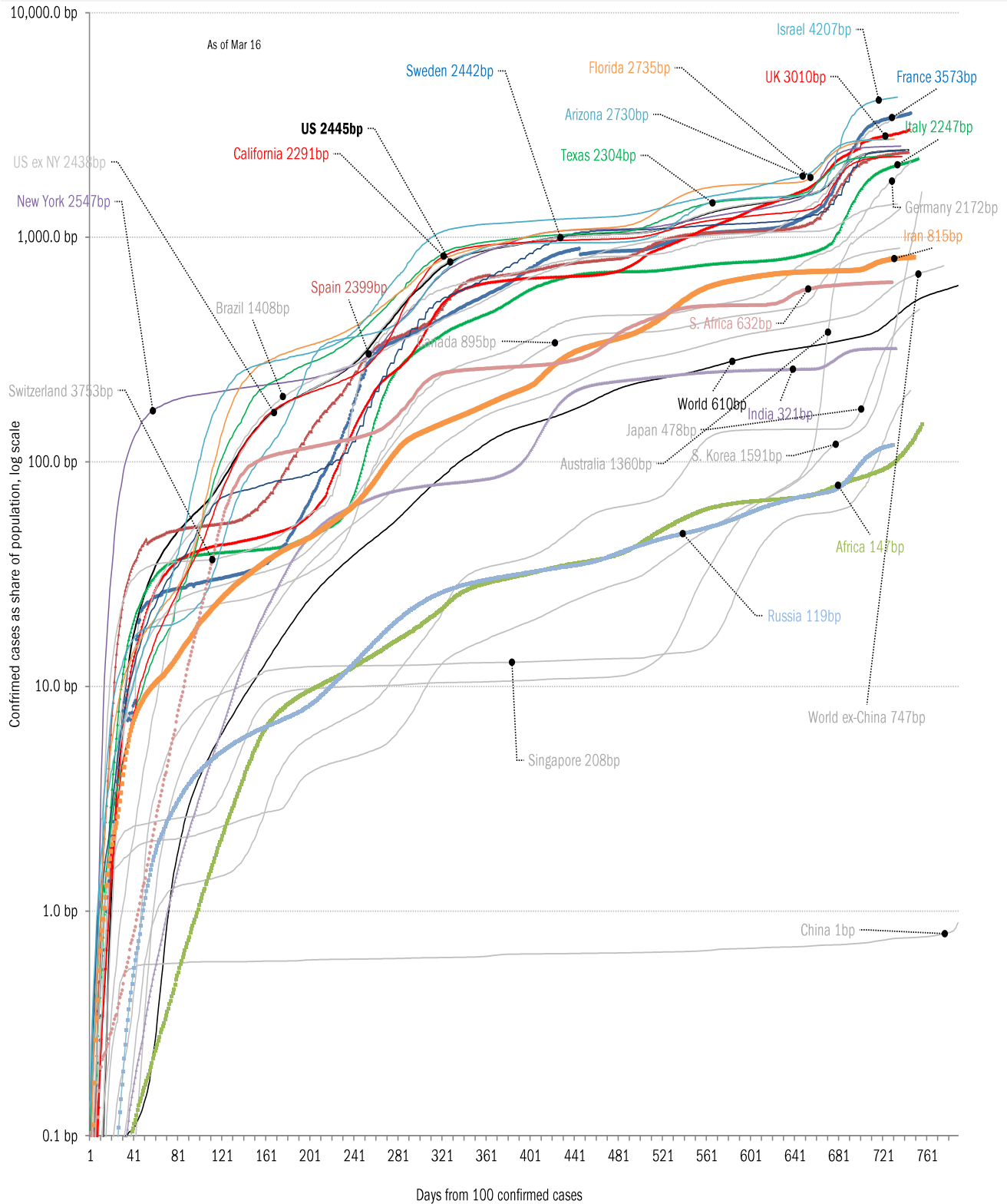

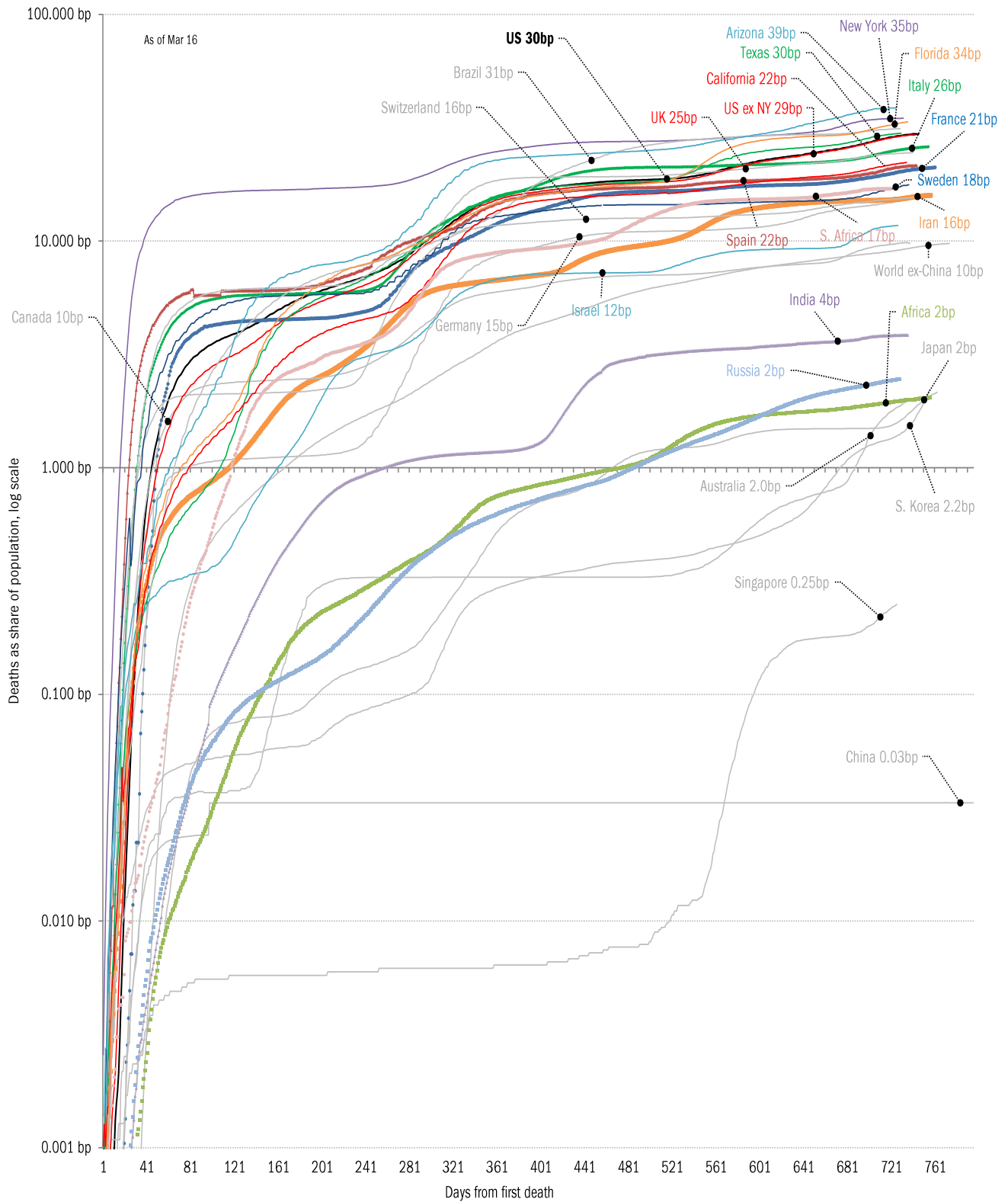

*Share of deceased population from day of first fatality, log scale*



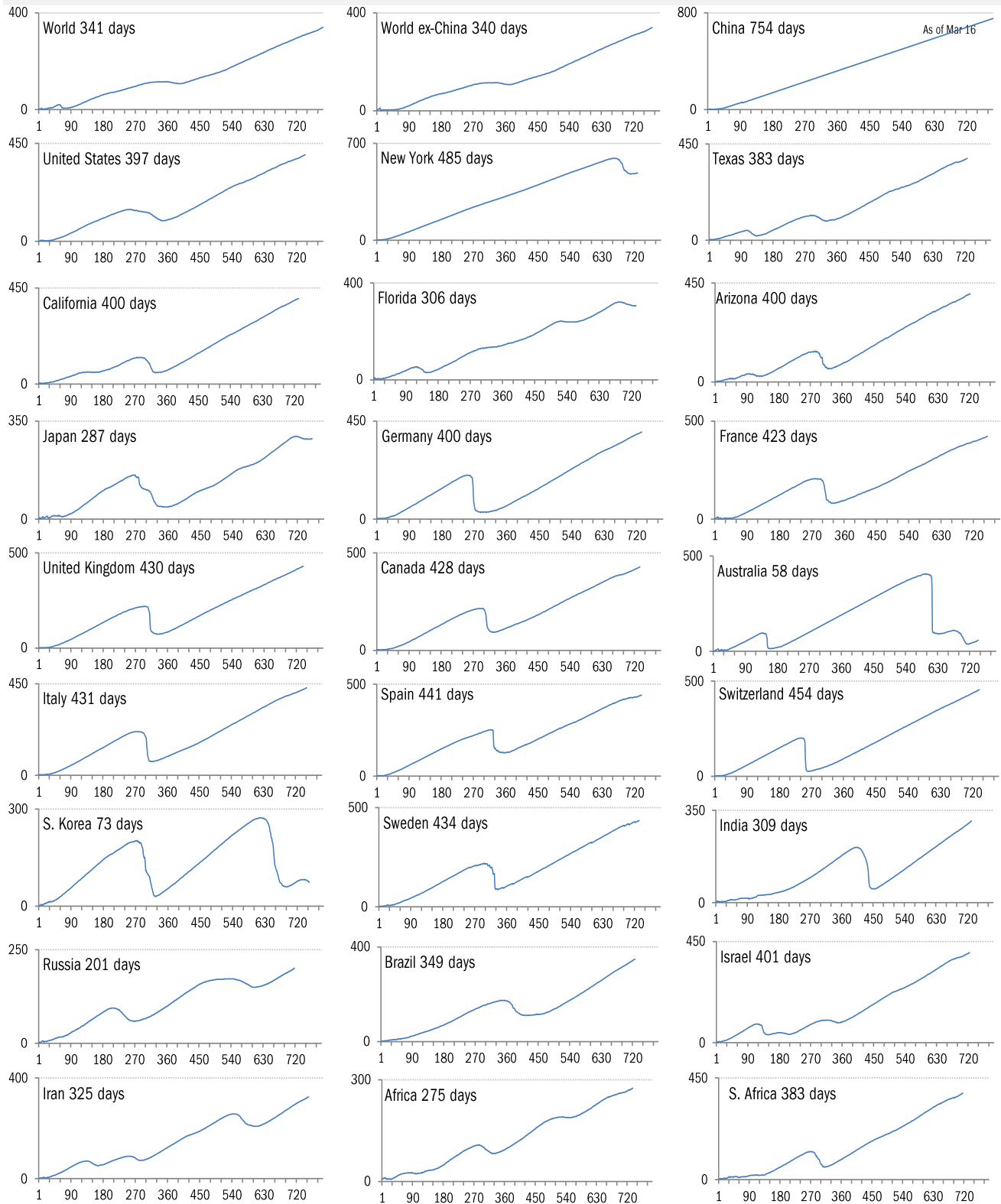

Flat indicates exponential spread Declining indicates supra-exponential spread Rising indicates sub-exponential spread

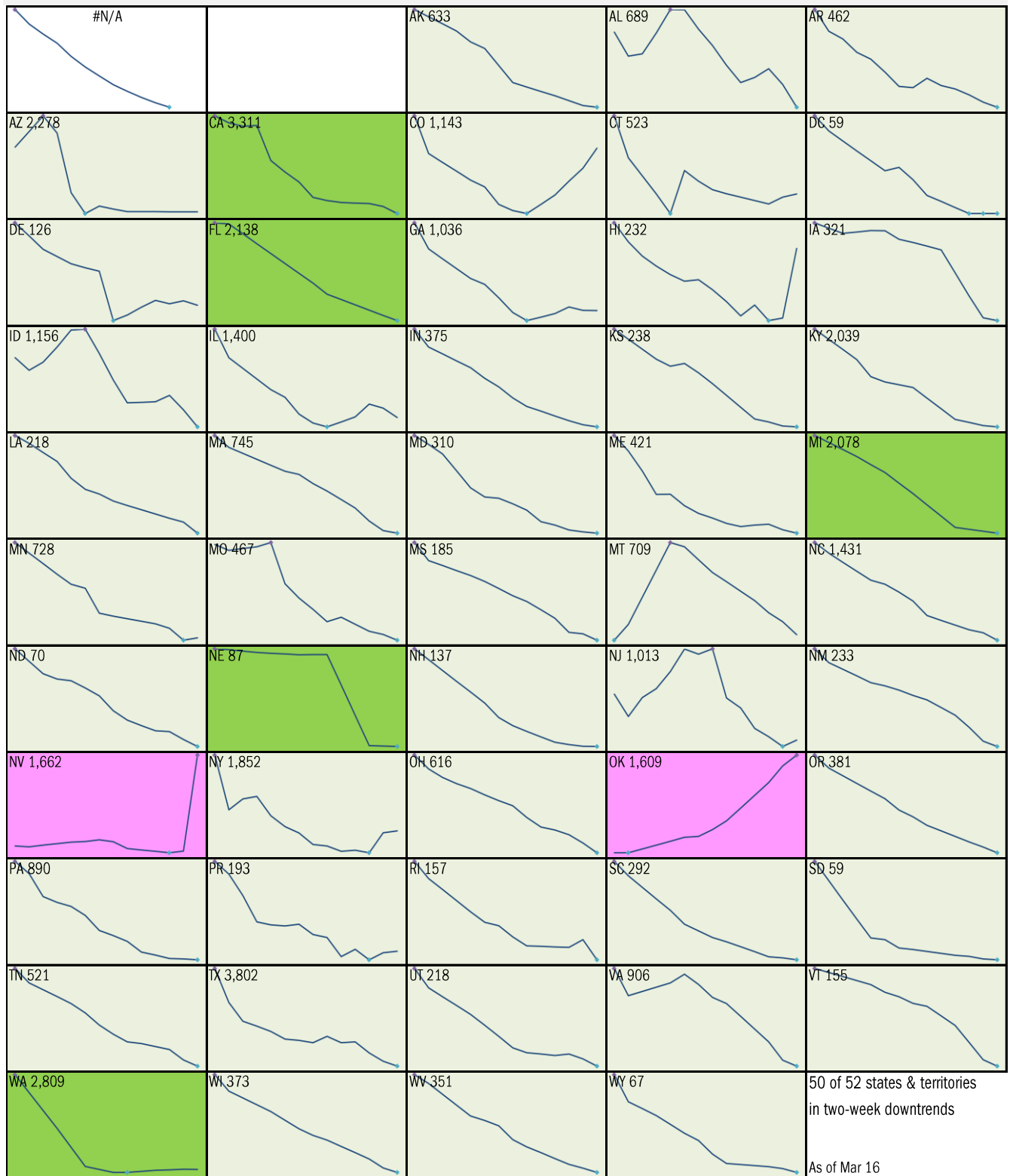

■ Downward trajectory ■ Five best ■ Upward trajectory ■ Five worst

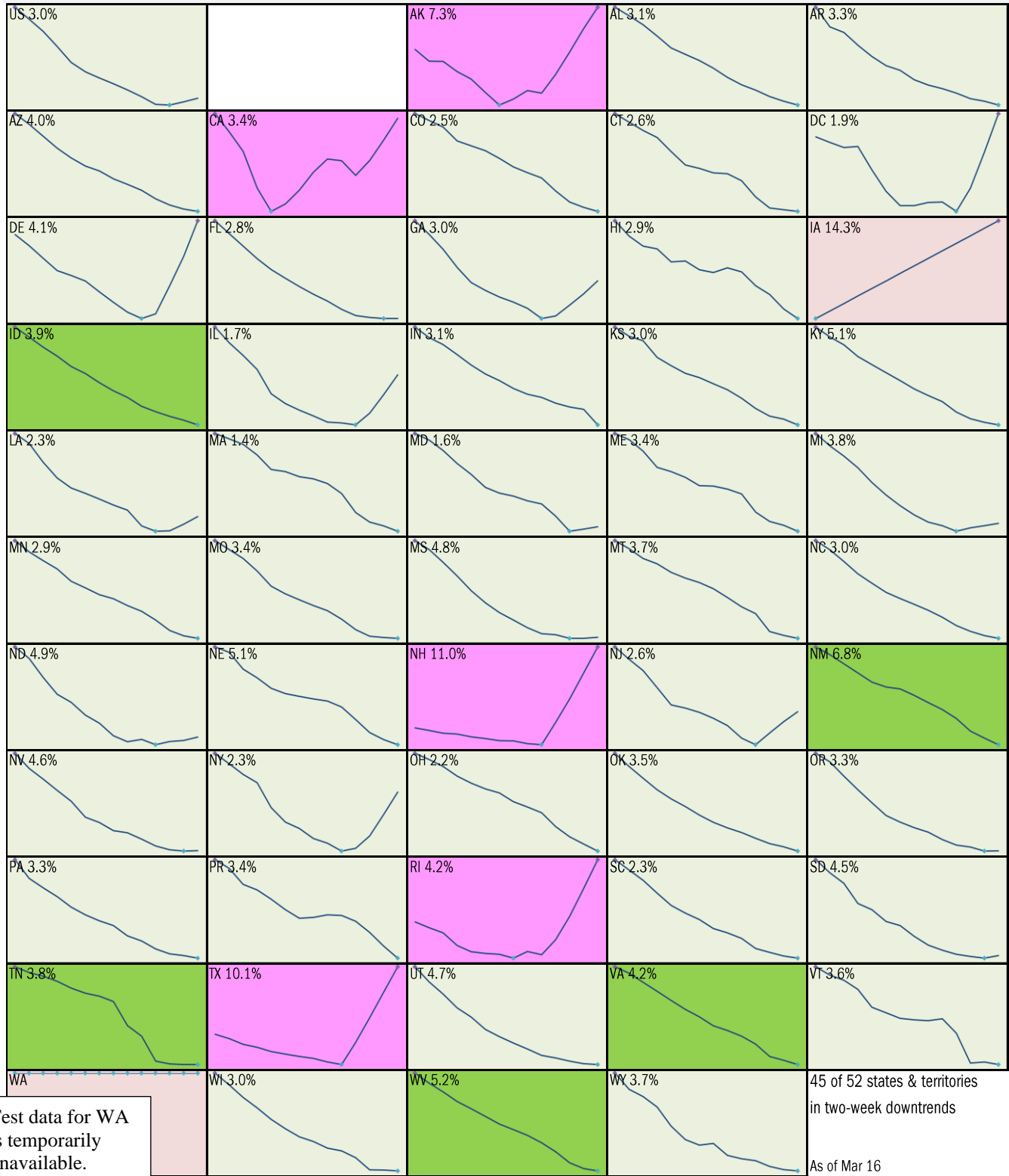

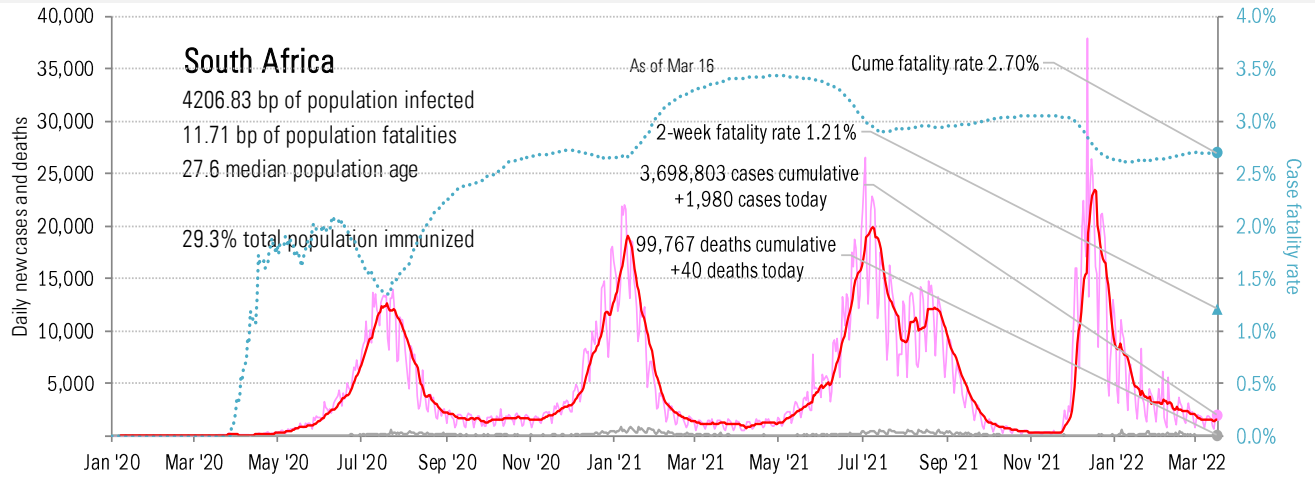
