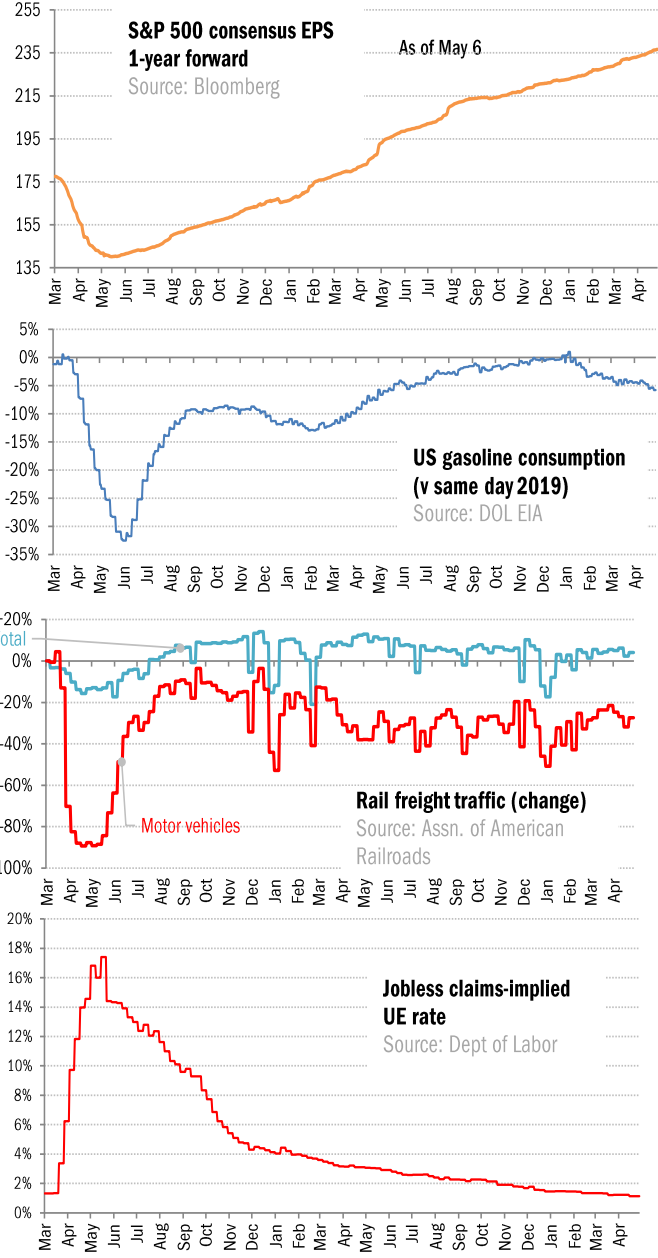
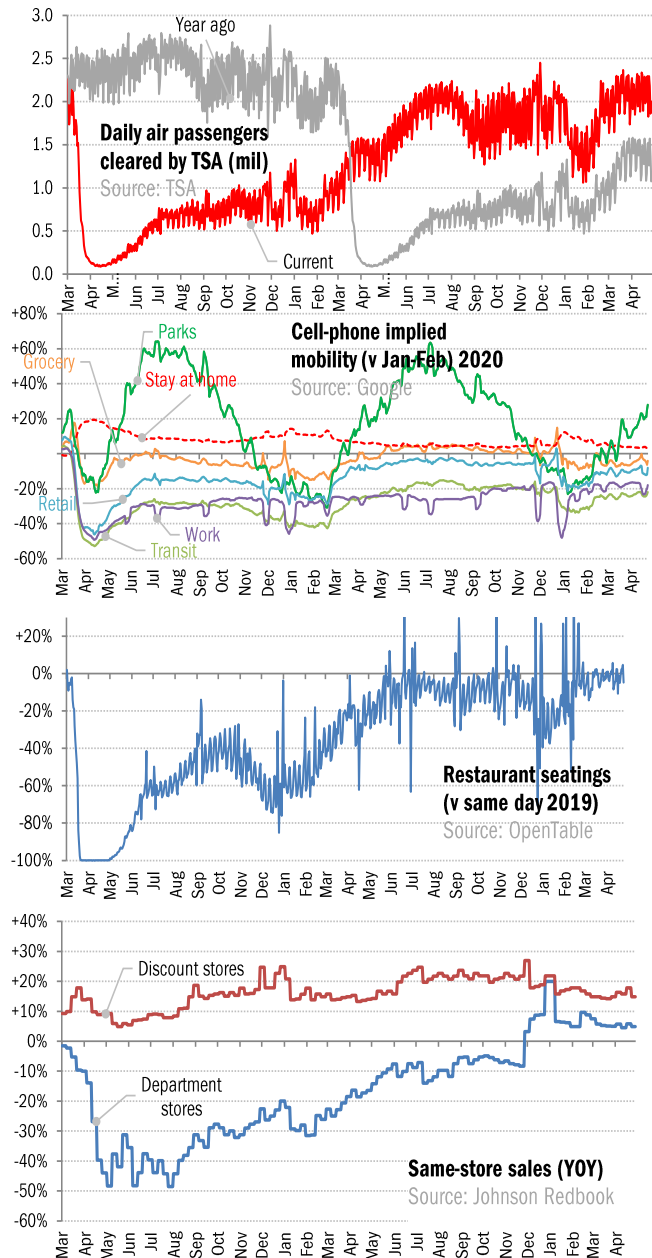

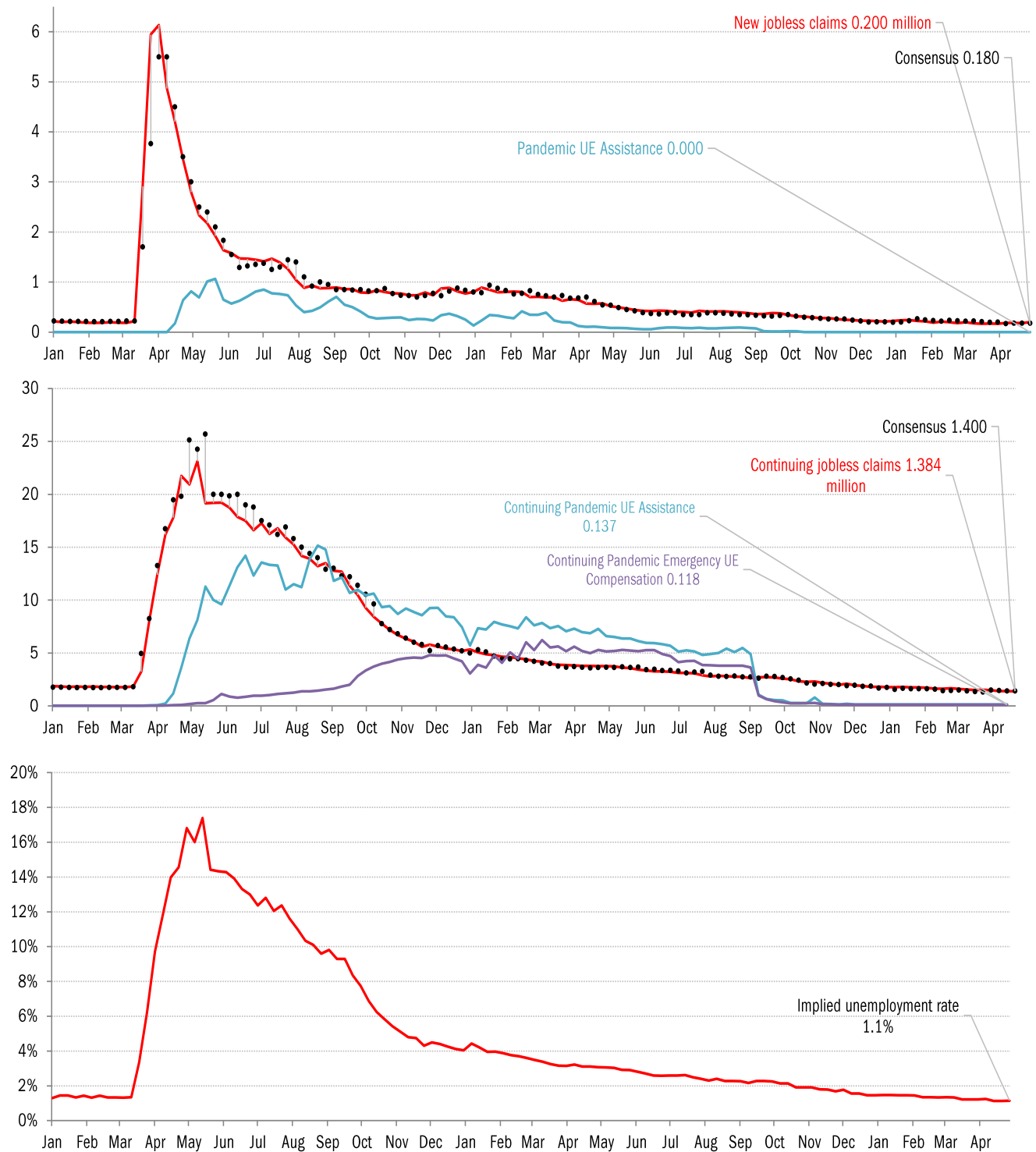
The US high-frequency macro data dashboard

High-frequency view of the US labor market: weekly unemployment claims (millions)



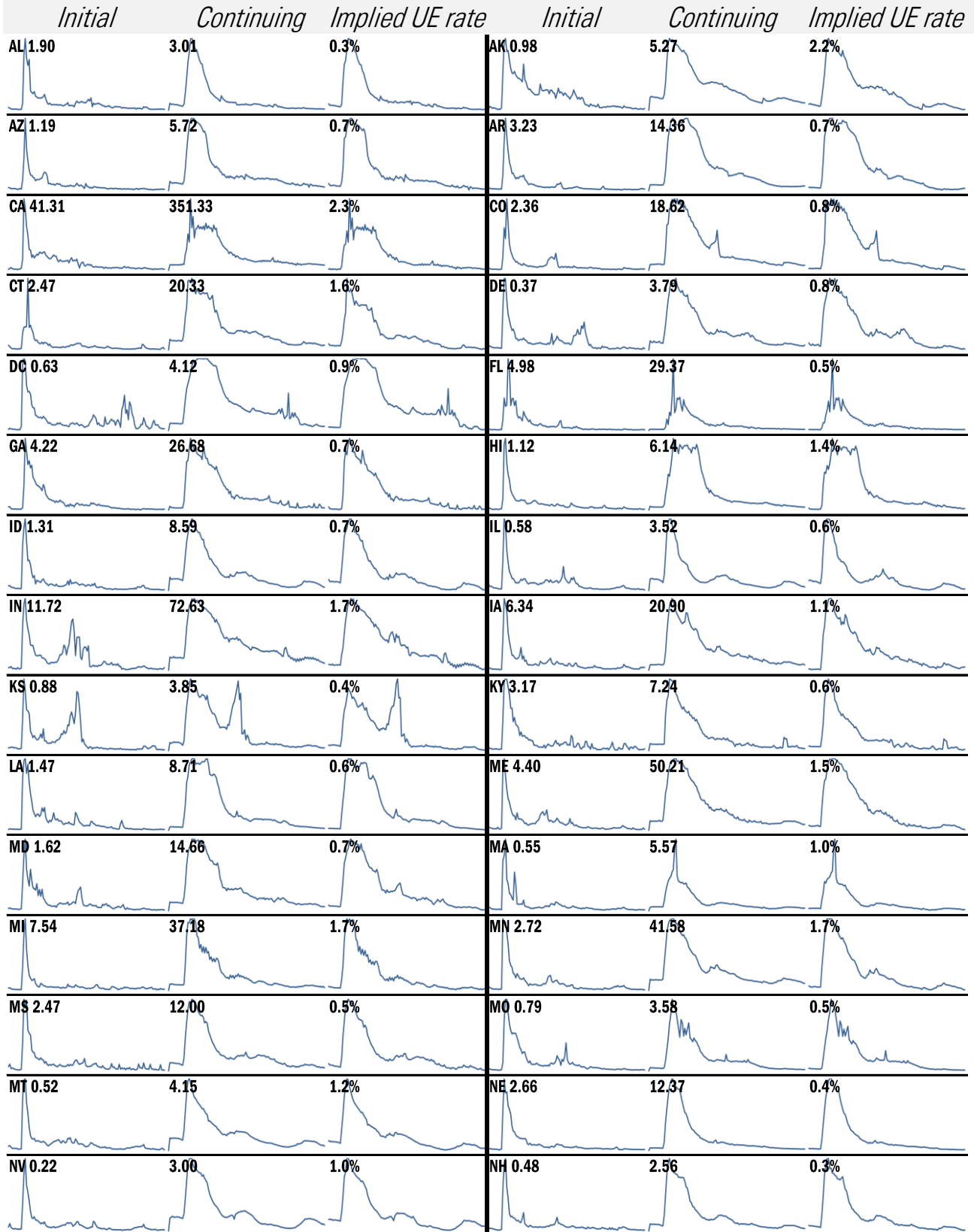

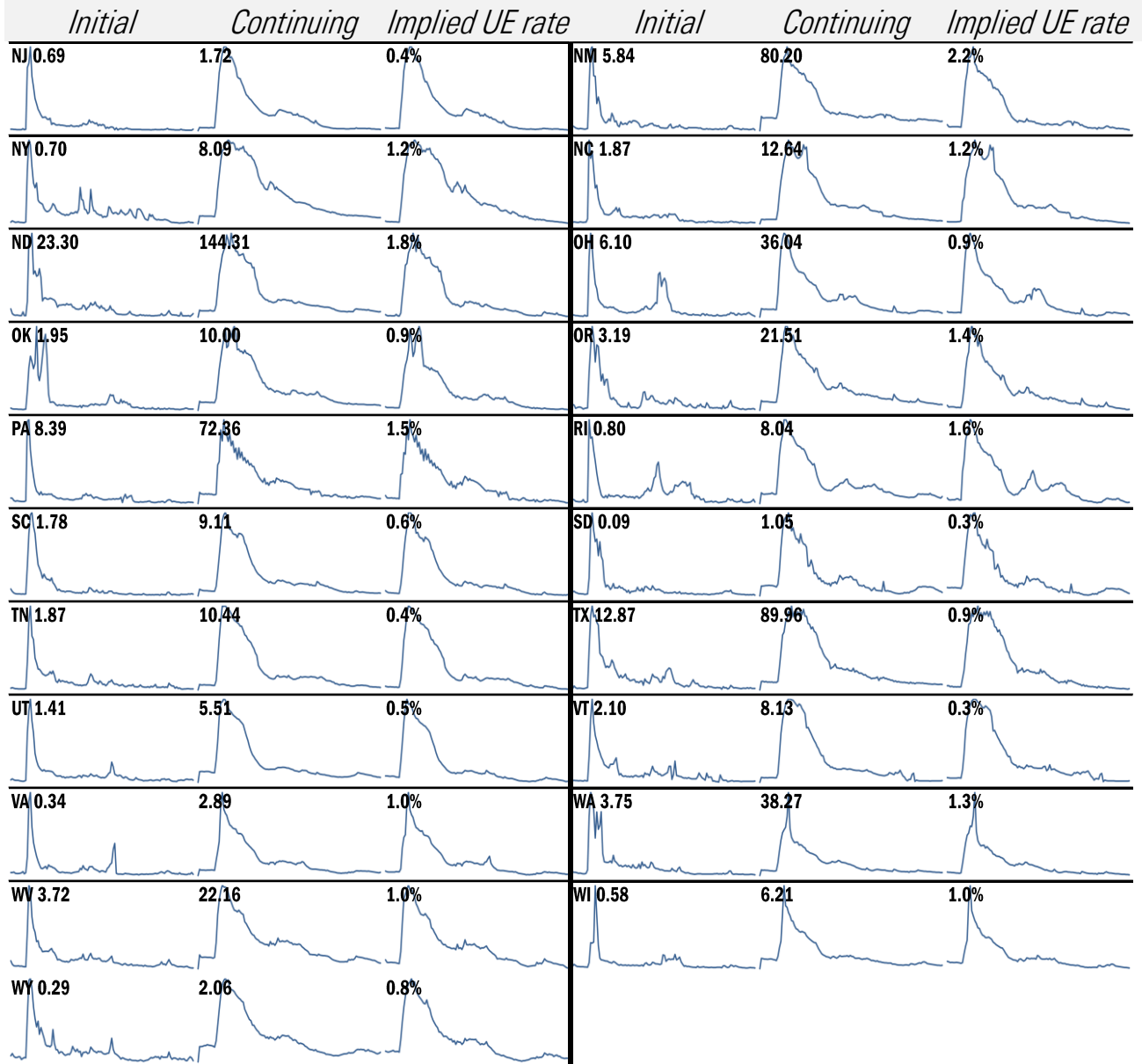

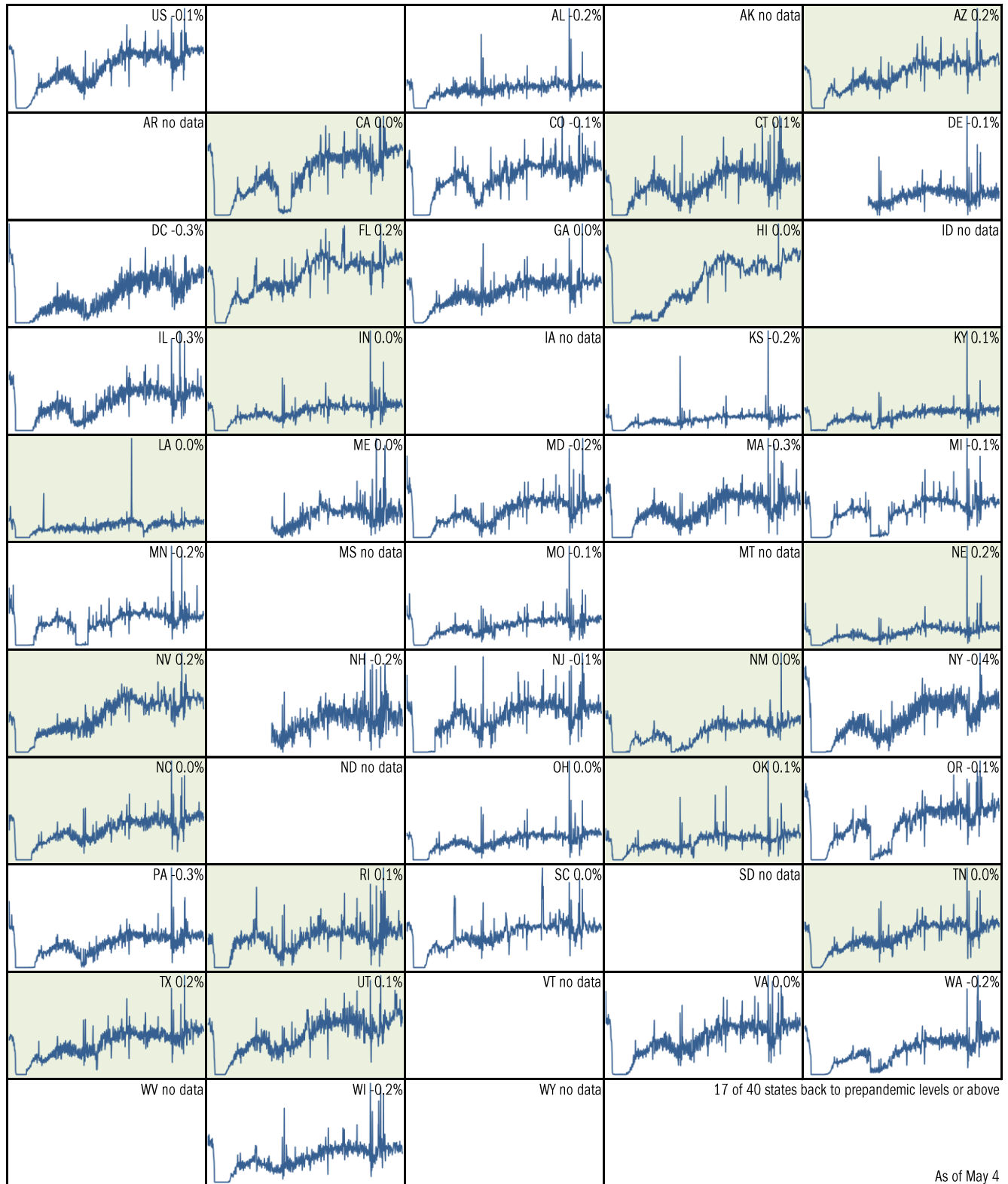
State by state unemployment insurance claims (thousands)

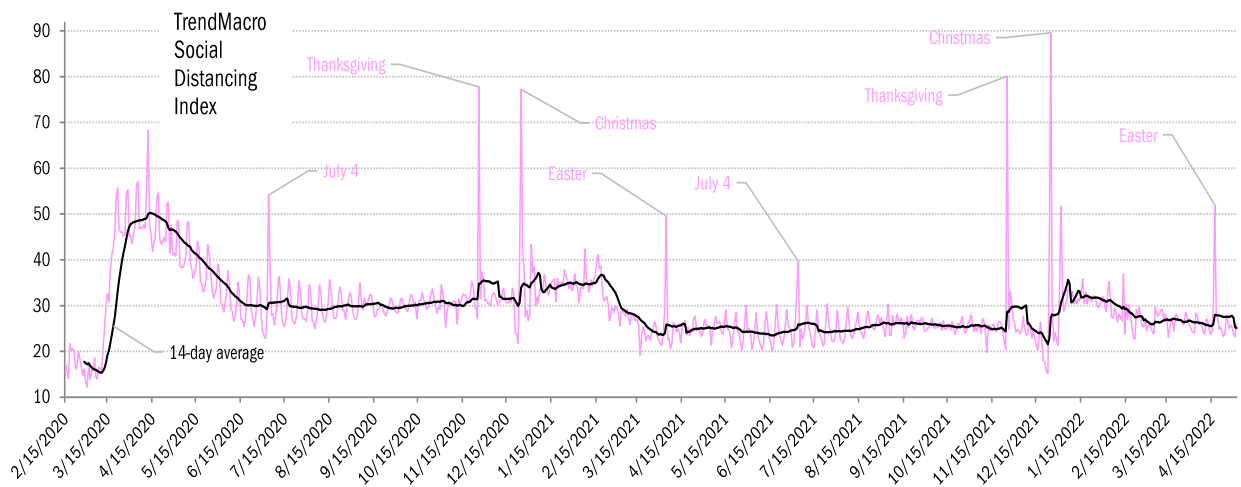
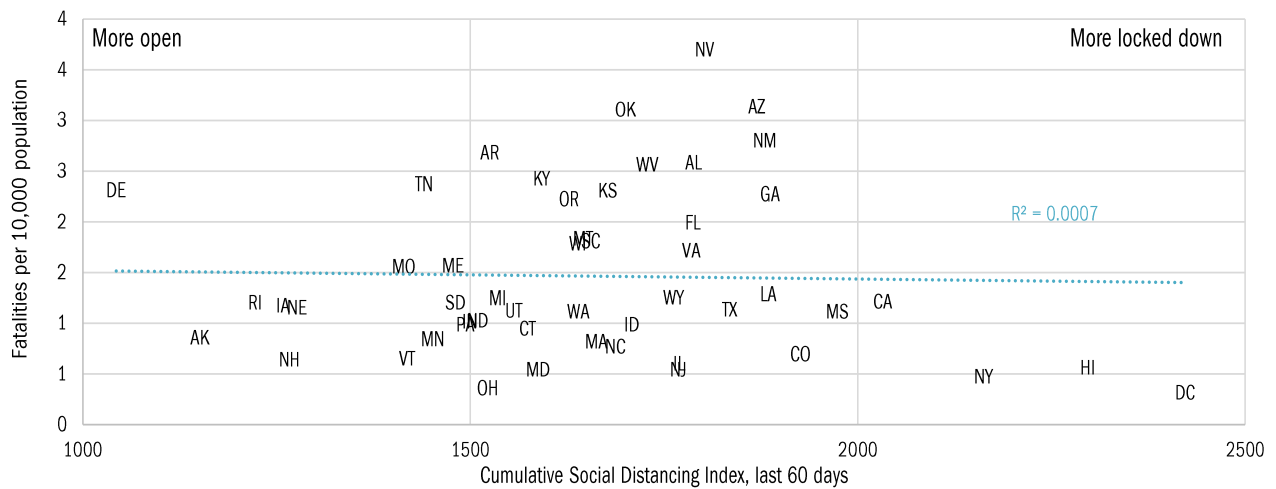
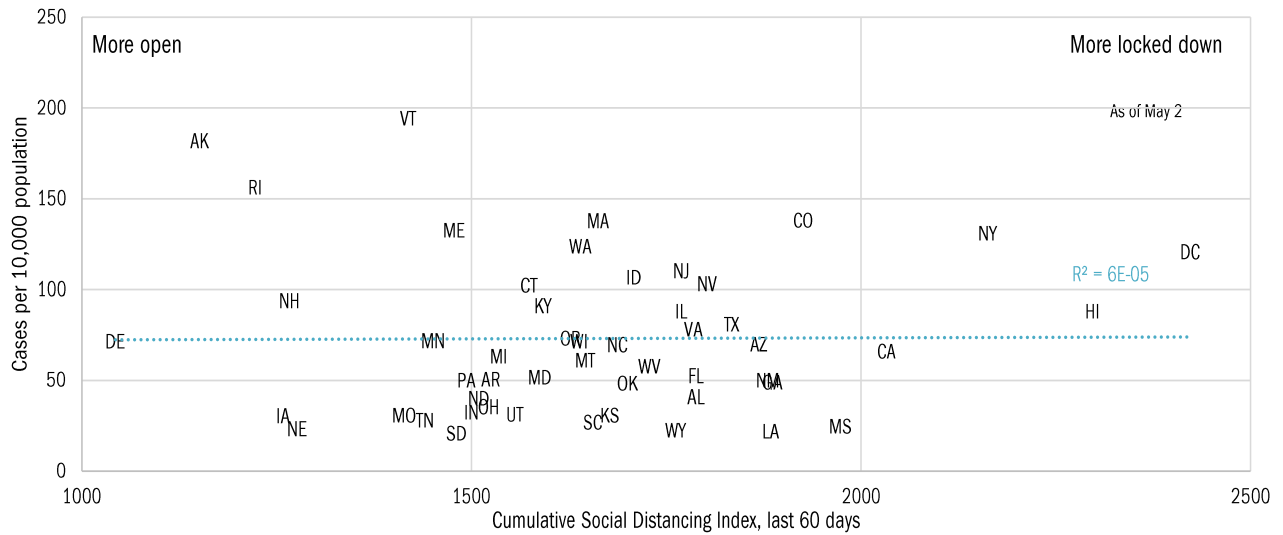
Seated diners in restaurants compared to 2019... Feb 2020 to present ■ Positive

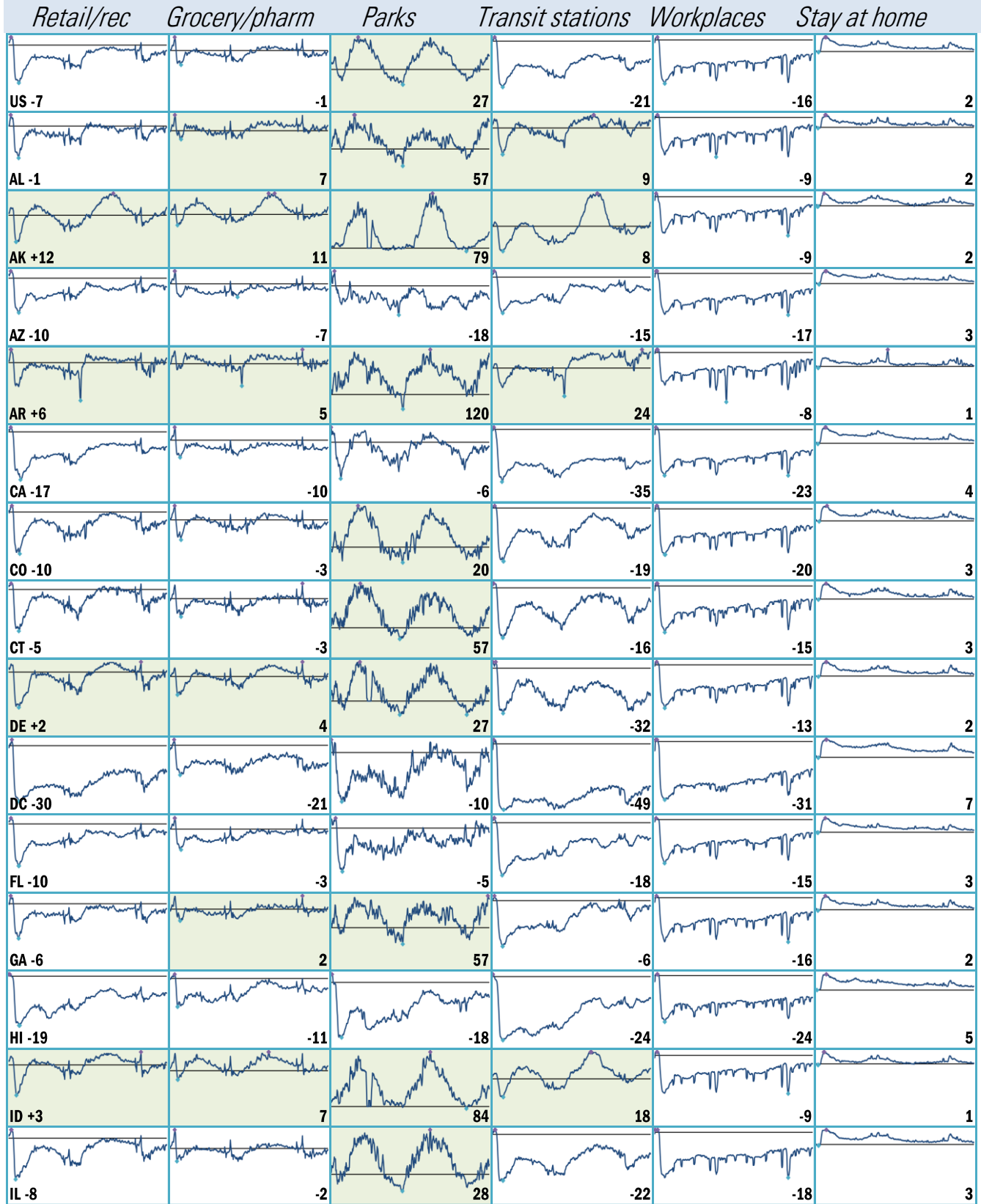
Re-opening the economy amidst ongoing pandemic risk

Covid-19 fatalities and cases *vs* social distancing measured by cell-phone mobility data



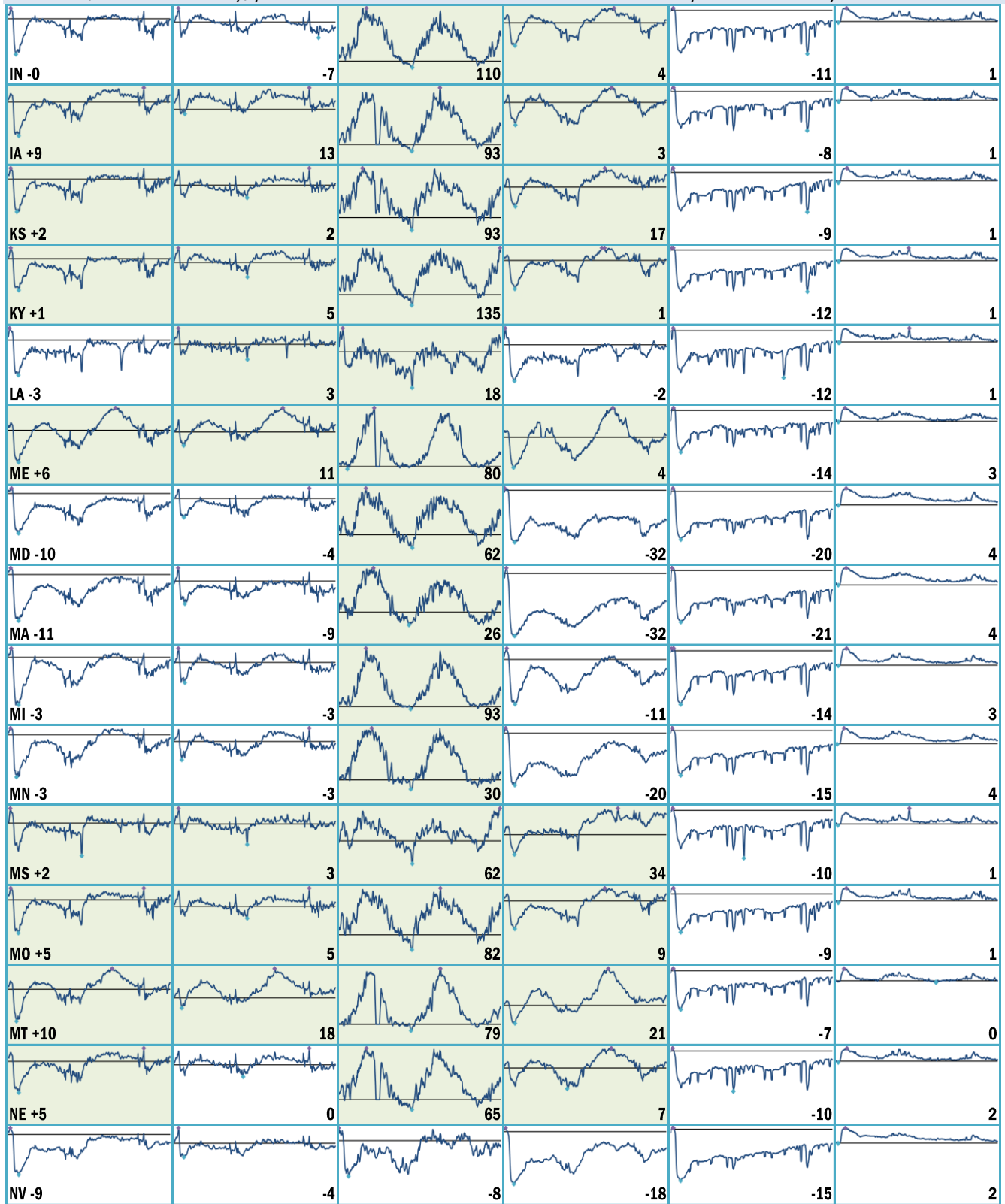

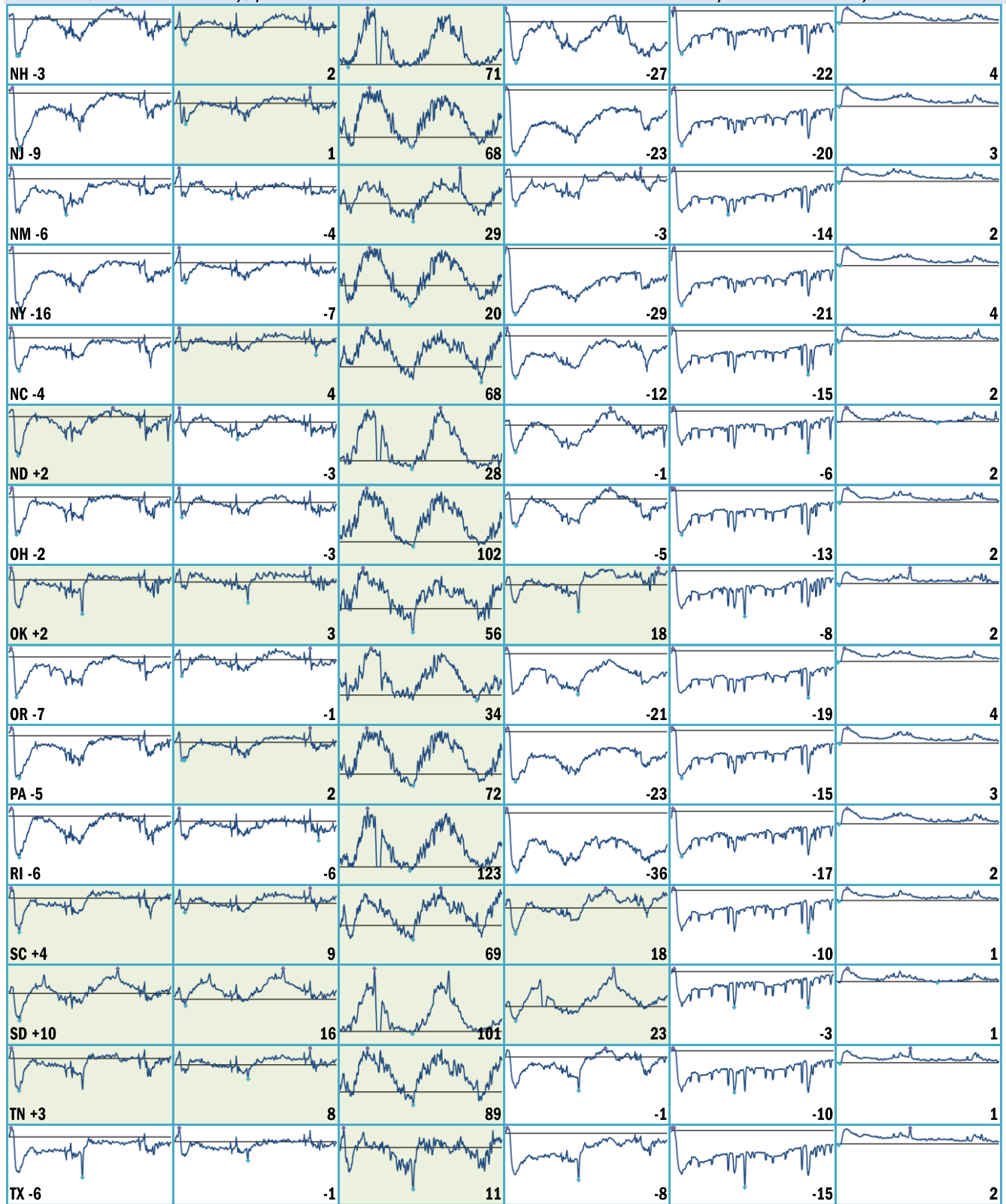

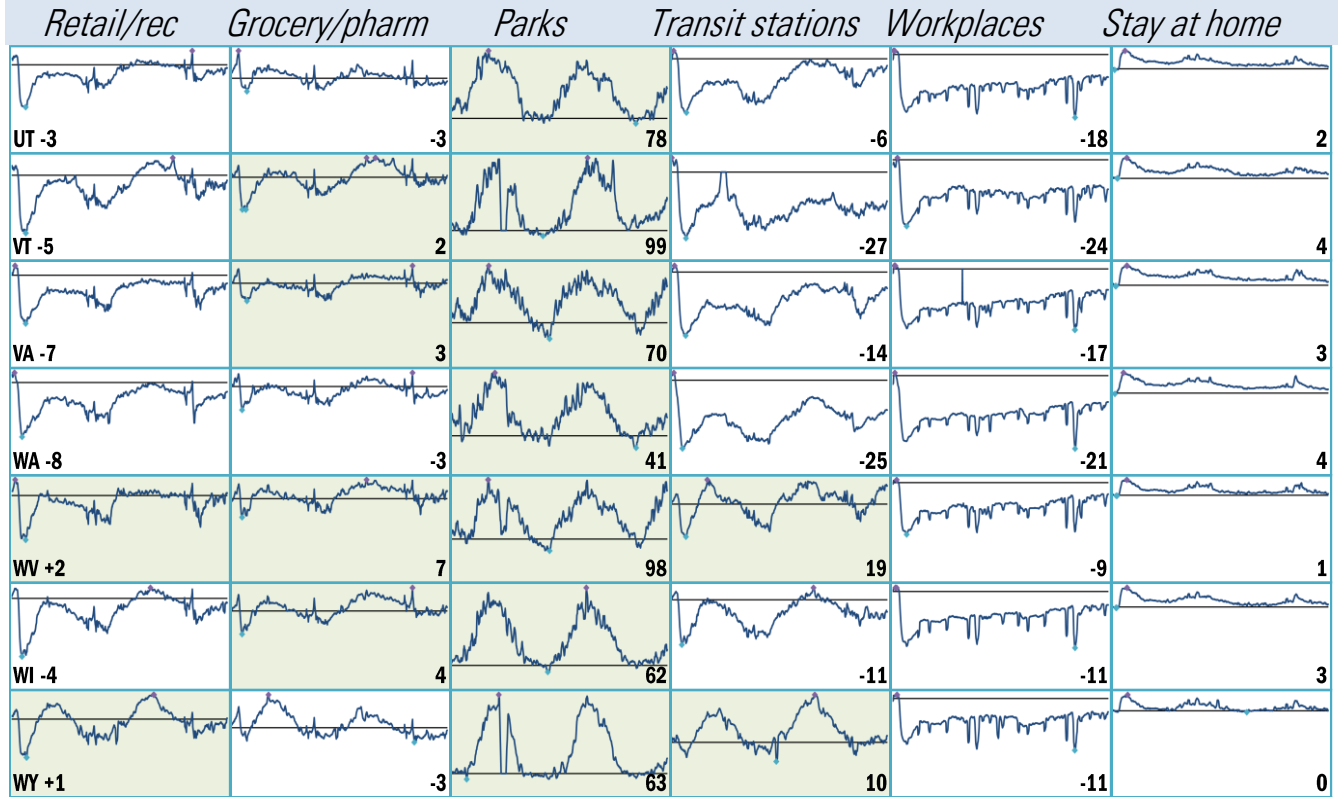
