

Supply chain pressure indices






Container shipping speed

Slower speed indicates congested ports




US purchasing managers index: backlog of orders growing









The ecosystem: <u>manufacturing and trade</u> sales and inventories vs personal income USD billions (DPI normalized to sale levels)









<u>Retail</u> inventories – where did the growth come from?


Contributions to nominal, sequential month change, SA Biggest change per detail-level: ■ positive ■ negative



<u>Retail</u> sales – where did the growth come from?



Wholesale sales -- where did the growth come from?


