
# US purchasing managers index: backlog of orders growing





# China purchasing managers index: improving time-to-delivery from suppliers Diffusion index













#### **Retail** sales – where did the growth come from?





#### **<u>Retail</u>** inventories — where did the growth come from?

Contributions to nominal, sequential month change, SA Biggest change per detail-level: ■ positive ■ negative





# Wholesale sales -- where did the growth come from?


Contributions to nominal, sequential month change, SA Biggest change per detail-level: ■ positive ■ negative
