






US purchasing managers index: backlog of orders growing




China purchasing managers index: improving time-to-delivery from suppliers Diffusion index








The Main Street sub-sub-ecosystem: <u>retail</u> sales and inventories <u>ex-auto</u> USD billions




Retail sales – where did the growth come from?




<u>Retail</u> inventories — where did the growth come from?





Wholesale sales -- where did the growth come from?


Contributions to nominal, sequential month change, SA Biggest change per detail-level: ■ positive ■ negative
